**Position Summary:**

The St. John's Congregational Music Assistant will assist the Director of Music in the following ways:

- Leading of music for all services including weddings, funerals, prayer, and Sunday services.
- Activity supporting the opportunity for congregational members to serve through music
- Participate in developing music worship in within other ministries.

The right candidate will have a clear understanding and strong grip of the Gospel. They will have demonstrated the ability in organ having a Christ focused comprehensive biblical theology. They will have demonstrated the ability to accompany congregational worship with organ and piano and provide choir direction.

**Requirements:**

Leading of music for all services

- Aid in planning and delivery of music worship for all types of services at St. John's
- Accompany congregation and choir with the organ and piano

Activity supporting the opportunity for congregational members to serve through music

- Help identify and encourage congregational members to serve in music ministry
- Support congregational members in connecting them with different ministries within the church body beyond music.
- Care for and encourage and aide in the development of congregational members serving in ministry.

Participate in developing music worship in within other ministries.

- Lead music at other congregational meetings as required
- Identify and develop areas for music ministry within the congregation.

- Musical:
  - Clearly articulated understanding of the role of Music within worship
  - Demonstrated ability to accompany congregational worship with organ.
  - Demonstrated ability to lead and conduct adult choir
- Pastoral
  - Demonstrated ability to involve congregational members in music ministry service.
  - Ability to connect people in need with other ministries at St. John's
- Relational Skills
  - Earning and keeping trust of others
  - Demonstrate in speech, conduct, love, faith and purity a genuine concern for others.
  - Able to lead, work alongside and take instruction from others and discern when to do what.
  - Demonstrate the ability to be taught by others and secure in one's point of view
  - Ability to deal with and/or defuse with conflict.

- Consistently growing and seeking the development of a Christ like character by taking heed to oneself through a personal and prayerful reality and authenticity with Christ.
- Demonstrate a personal and martial lifestyle consistent with Gospel standards
